## Terms and Conditions

2. The 5 winners will be selected by a random draw from all valid entries received in accordance with these terms and conditions. Unsuccessful entrants will not be contacted. The decision of the Wellbeing of Women on all matters is final.
3. There is no purchase necessary to enter.
4. The prize draw opens at 12:00pm GMT on 13/07/2020 and closes at 12:00pm pm GMT on 16/07/2020. Any entries received outside these specified times and dates will not be eligible for entry into the prize draw.

The winner's will be contacted by a member of Wellbeing of Women marketing team by Monday 20th July 2020 and MUST respond by midnight within seven days of the date of contact, providing a valid GB address for the prize to be dispatched to. If a selected winner does not meet all of the entry conditions or refuses the prize, another entrant will be selected at random from the remaining eligible entries within a reasonable timeframe.
